Meeting Minutes

January 10, 2024

The Imperial County CCP Program & Development Subcommittee met through the telecommunication service Zoom on Wednesday, January 10, 2024 at 2:00 p.m.

Members Present: Don Gorham, Antonio Garcia, Sgt. Figueroa, Fernando Jimenez, Cpt. Juan Chavarin, Lt. James Vooris, Diana Aguirre, Carlos Contreras, Jose Garcia, Elizabeth Sais, Dan Prince

Call to Order:

Mr. Fernando Jimenez welcomed attending members and guests, and called the meeting to order at 2:00 p.m.

a. Roll Call

Mr. Jose Ramirez conducted roll call over Zoom.

b. Discussion and approval for the continued use of telecommunication services based on current circumstances and local guidelines for a 30-day period.

Mr. Jimenez went over the telecommunication resolution regarding the continued use of Zoom for future meetings; Mr. Carlos Contreras motioned to approve the resolution; Mr. Don Gorham seconded the motion; the motion passed unanimously.

c. Approval of CCP Meeting Minutes from November 1, 2023

After review of the October 4, 2023 minutes, Mr. Contreras motioned to approve the minutes; Cpt. Chavarin seconded the motion; the motion passed unanimously.

Discussion/Action Items

a. Discussion regarding DRC program reporting

Mr. Jimenez stated that the Probation Department is hoping to create a calendar for events that are ongoing at the Day Reporting Center, and they wanted to perform additional tracking for people coming in for programs and services.

Agency Updates:

a. Probation Department

Mr. Jimenez thanked everyone for all the support and help with the Adult Summit event back in November and stated that it had a great turnout due to the tremendous work put in by the event organizers.

b. Imperial County Sheriff's Office

Cpt. Chavarin stated that ICSO would be switching to a new jail management system by the end of the month and there may be some delays with bookings. Cpt. Chavarin noted that ICSO may be requesting the CCP to approve a new position for the Sheriff's Office.

c. GEO

Mr. Contreras stated that GEO currently has 64 participants enrolled into the program due to some recent discharges. Mr. Contreras added that GEO is looking to work with an agency that will provide employment training that should help participants learn skills related to some of the new Geothermal and Lithium companies coming to Imperial County.

d. SMART Recovery

Mr. Gorham stated that SMART Recovery currently has 5 face-to-face groups and 3 zoom groups with 36 clients enrolled in the face-to-face groups and 25 enrolled in the zoom groups.

e. Behavioral Health Services

Ms. Diana Aguirre stated that the agency will be working on a contingency management program, which is an incentive based program for those with a stimulant disorder.

Informational Item(s), and Announcements:

Mr. Gorham stated that the Adult Summit speakers did a great job and there might be some possibilities that local speakers may be more impactful than the celebrity speakers they normally get for the event.

Chief Prince stated that there is a lot of ongoing changes happening at the state level that will be impacting programs and services for adults and AB109 individuals, with strong changes to the CARE Court system, which will require Probation and Behavioral Health to be more involved. Chief Prince noted that they would keep members of this committee updated on any further changes.

Mr. Jimenez adjourned the meeting at 2:45 p.m. The next CCP Program and Development Subcommittee meeting would be scheduled in February 2024.
