Meeting Minutes March 6, 2024

The Imperial County CCP Program & Development Subcommittee met through the telecommunication service Zoom on Wednesday, March 6, 2024 at 2:00 p.m.

Call to Order:

Mr. Everardo Rodriguez stated he would be standing in for Mr. Fernando Jimenez today, welcomed attending members and guests, and called the meeting to order at 2:05 p.m.

a. Roll Call

Mr. Jose Ramirez conducted roll call over Zoom.

b. Discussion and approval for the continued use of telecommunication services based on current circumstances and local guidelines for a 30-day period.

Mr. Rodriguez went over the telecommunication resolution regarding the continued use of Zoom for future meetings; Mr. Don Gorham motioned to approve the resolution; Mr. Brian Melvin seconded the motion; the motion passed unanimously.

c. Approval of CCP Meeting Minutes from January 10, 2024

After review of the January 10, 2024, minutes, Mr. Hernandez motioned to approve the minutes; Mr. Gorham seconded the motion; the motion passed unanimously.

Discussion/Action Items

There were no items for discussion / action.

Agency Updates:

a. Probation Department

Mr. Oswaldo Guerrero provided an update on Pretrial Services for the Probation Department and stated that in January the Department completed 32 Progress Reports, 23 Humphrey Assessments and 109 Pre-arraignment interview / assessments. Mr. Guerrero noted that currently the Department has 325 active pretrial cases with 22 cases on Electronic Monitoring.

b. Imperial County Sheriff's Office

Cpl. Sergio Romero stated that the Charter School currently has 19 inmates enrolled into the program and the Inside/Out college program currently has 7 Outside students and 6 Inside students participating. Cpl. Romero added that the Community Work Service crews are still going out into the community and providing various clean up and garbage disposal services.

c. GEO Group

Mr. Contreras stated that GEO currently has 70 participants enrolled into the program and has 5 participants about to complete their requirements by the end of this week. Mr. Contreras noted that they are looking to host a graduation event soon along with a 10-year celebration event for the DRC. Mr. Contreras added that they are continuing to work with CEI who will be providing training classes in April for skills related to the thermal and lithium plants within Imperial County. Mr. Contreras also stated that the CDCR will also being providing certification courses for CAL OHSHA which will allow participants to pick up union work.

d. SMART Recovery

Mr. Gorham stated that SMART Recovery is currently operating their five face to face groups along with one in Spanish and two more through zoom. Mr. Gorham noted that they are working towards hosting a public forum regarding fentanyl some time in September to provide information to the community.

e. ICOE Charter School

Mr. Garcia stated that the Charter School program at the DRC currently has 30 students enrolled into the program, consisting of 19 from the Sheriff's Office, 9 from the Probation Department, and 2 from the schools. Mr. Garcia noted that they have 10 more students pending enrollment and are projecting that 15 students graduate this semester.

DRC Library Services

Ms. Monica Reyes stated that they didn't have any major updates to provide at this time but they are looking to start services at the DRC two days a week and possibly on Wednesday and Friday.
