The Imperial County CCP Training Committee met through the telecommunication service Zoom on Thursday, April 4, 2024 at 9:30 a.m.

Members Present: Elizabeth Sais, Don Gorham, Catherine Apalategui, Romero Sergio

Guest(s): Jose Luis Ramirez

Call to Order:

Ms. Elizabeth Sais called the meeting to order at 9:35 a.m. Roll call was conducted through Zoom.

Approval of Telecommunication Services:

After review of the resolution to continue using telecommunication services, Ms. Sais moved to approve the resolution and Mr. Gorham seconded the motion; the motion passed unanimously.

Approval of CCP Meeting Minutes:

After review of the March 14, 2024, minutes, Ms. Sais motioned to approve the minutes, Mr. Gorham seconded the motion; the motion passed unanimously.

Discussion / Action Item(s):

a. Discussion / Approval to Fund Travel and Attendance for 12 Staff Members to the APPA 49th Annual Training Institute Conference from June 27-July 2, 2024, in Indianapolis, IN at an estimated cost of \$28,738.92.

Ms. Sais stated that this event usually happens a little later in the summer but this year they are hosting it a bit early in a new city. Ms. Sais noted that the Probation Department is requesting funding for 12 staff members to attend the event with the normal process of allowing CCP Executive members to select 1-2 members of their agencies to attend as well, with any unused spots to be filled by Probation staff. Ms. Sais added that the APPA events are always great opportunities for participants to learn about ongoing issues, network with other counties, and attend various workshops.

Cpl. Romero stated that the APPA training seems like the American Justice Association event that is hosted yearly. Ms. Sais responded that it is similar, and it would be a good opportunity for Sheriff staff to attend this event as well.

Mr. Gorham motioned to approve this item; Cpl. Romero seconded the motion; the motion carried and passed unanimously.

Ms. Sais stated that the Probation Department will be hosting their Youth Summit later this month at the McCabe school and they were able to get a guest speaker who should connect well with the kids.

Cpl. Romero stated he will be meeting with a representative of the Institute of Southern California to get information on starting up their Barbering course at the jail.

SMART Recovery

Mr. Gorham stated that SMART is planning on hosting its public forum regarding fentanyl on September 24 at Desert Trails, and they are hoping to get a lot of parents involved to provide information and gain additional community feedback.
