**Call to Order:**

Ms. Elizabeth Sais welcomed the attending members and guests and called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m. Ms. Sais stated that she would be chairing the CCP Budget & Fiscal meetings while Ms. Catherine Apalategui was out of the office.

**Approval of CCP Meeting Minutes:**

After review of the February 13, 2025, minutes, Mr. Eleanor Baraza motioned to approve the minutes; Ms. Vanessa Lopez seconded the motion; the motion passed unanimously.

**Discussion / Action Item(s):**

**a. Sheriff's Office – CCP funding request to send six (6) staff to the American Jail Association Annual Conference held in Fort Worth, Texas from May 17th – May 21st, 2025.**

Cpt. Chavarin presented this item on behalf of the Sheriff's Office and stated that they were requesting funding to send 6 staff members to attend the upcoming American Jail Association Annual Conference, the attending staff would consist of 4 Sheriff Officers and 2 ICBHS staff that work at the jail. Cpt. Chavarin noted the various workshops and trainings that would be available for the attending members and added that it's a great opportunity for staff to learn about upcoming trends and new technologies. Cpt. Chavarin added that they are also requesting additional funding to rent a vehicle for attending members as they will be doing jail facility tours in the area.

**b. District Attorney's Office – CCP funding request to send two (2) Criminal Research Specialist to basic intelligence analyst training in Chandler, Arizona from March 24th – April 4th, 2025, in the amount not to exceed \$3,500.**

Mr. Carl Armstrong thanked the CCP for sending some of the District Attorney's staff to the recent APPA conference and stated that the District Attorney's Office was requesting some additional funding for a training session for two Criminal Research specialist staff members. Mr. Armstrong noted that this training would set up a good foundation for the new staff members and allow them to build up a skill set for their new role.
