# Calexico Police Department

**Subject:** Request for Funding Assistance for Records Technician Overtime

The Calexico Police Department respectfully requests funding assistance in the amount of \$24,500.00 from Imperial County Community Corrections Partnership for the purpose of covering overtime costs associated with one Calexico Police Department Records Technician.

The requested funding will be utilized specifically to address the Department's substantial backlog of criminal case file processing and data entry. At this time, the Department is experiencing an approximate twelve (12) month backlog in criminal related records and case file completion. This backlog has significantly impacted the timely processing, submission, retrieval, and management of criminal case information associated with AB109-related offenders, investigations, and enforcement activities.

Due to ongoing staffing shortages, increased workload demands, and limited available personnel resources, the Department has been unable to dedicate sufficient staff time during regular business hours to adequately address the backlog. As a result, assigning overtime hours to a Records Technician has become necessary to ensure compliance, improve operational efficiency, and maintain accurate and timely records management.

The Records Technician assigned under this request will primarily focus on:

- Completing and updating outstanding criminal case files
- Processing and organizing criminal arrest and investigation records
- Ensuring timely data entry into records management systems
- Assisting with records retrieval and case preparation related to AB109 compliance and enforcement efforts
- Reducing the current twelve-month backlog in criminal records processing

The requested overtime funding will directly support the Calexico Police Department's efforts to improve records management efficiency, support criminal justice operations, and enhance

coordination with partner agencies involved in AB109 supervision, enforcement, and rehabilitation efforts.

The Calexico Police Department appreciates the Imperial County Community Corrections Partnership's continued support and consideration of this funding request. These funds would significantly assist the Department in addressing critical operational needs while improving the timely management of criminal case records and related AB109 documentation.

## **Recommendation:**

The Imperial County Sheriff's Office, in collaboration with the Imperial County Probation Office and District Attorneys Office, jointly request the CCP Executive Committee to approve funding for Peregrine Technologies at a combined total of \$435,000 for a two year contract to provide services and resource as an investigative resource and crime solving tool. Additional, integration fees of \$8,036 will also be included of the request.

## **Background:**

Peregrine Technologies directly addresses the core objectives outlined in Imperial County's Public Safety Realignment Plan, specifically enhancing inter-agency collaboration, improving public safety outcomes, and streamlining offender supervision in line with AB109 mandates.

Currently, critical public safety information across the cooperating agencies is fragmented across multiple isolated systems. This siloed data structure significantly impairs our ability to efficiently monitor offenders, identify risk patterns, and swiftly respond to incidents, thereby compromising public safety and offender rehabilitation efforts.

Peregrine Technologies integrates disparate systems into a centralized, real-time dashboard, accessible across multiple agencies. For the Sheriff's Office, Peregrine will integrate ProPhoenix CAD/RMS/JMS, Axon BWC, Flock, Viapath, Civil Serve and Spillman CAD. For the Imperial County Probation Office, integrations include e-probation. The District Attorneys Officer will be integrating e-prosecutor and the courts will be integrating e-courts. This integration will ensure comprehensive visibility into offender profiles, real-time activities, and historical interactions—essential for proactive management under AB109.

This is a county-wide initiative designed to significantly enhance interoperability between law enforcement agencies, Probation, District Attorney's Office, Behavioral Health, and Social Services. However, the Sheriff's Office will be taking the lead on this project due to their existing internal IT resources capable of managing the scale and complexity of implementation.

## **Benefits and Alignment to CCP Goals:**

**Enhanced Public Safety:** Provides officers immediate access to comprehensive offender data, reducing risks associated with incomplete or inaccessible information.

**Improved Community Supervision:** Enhances the ability of probation officers and community supervision teams to monitor compliance and quickly address emerging risks or violations, leading to more effective offender management and rehabilitation outcomes.

**Operational Efficiency:** Reduces time-intensive data searches, freeing officer capacity to engage more directly in community supervision and rehabilitation initiatives.

**Improved Interagency Coordination:** Strengthens collaboration between probation, law enforcement, behavioral health, and social services, critical under the AB109 realignment framework.

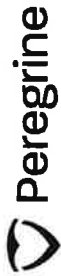
**Financial Impact:**

A 2 year contract request for \$435,000 has been obtained with third and fourth year optional options. Additionally identified is an \$8,036 integration cost for ProPhoenix (CAD) operability. The request is for a two year contract utilizing CCP annual funding, justified by significant operational improvements and alignment with the CCP's strategic realignment goals. A 12 month and 18 month report will be provided to the CCP executive board for assessment of future endeavors to continue with a 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> year agreement. The total request for this action is \$443,036.
